The solution described should work for all shotguns that have barrel extensions that are similar to the Remington and Beretta gas operated semi-autos.

Dear Technoid,

I noticed in one of the letters to you a reader has asked about a way to keep empties ejected from the 303 from going to far, and hitting other shooters.

A simple 1/8" diameter button can easily be silver soldered to the barrel extension, and it will make the empties go slightly forward and down. I have installed a few, and have not had any malfunction problems. The location is easily determined by measuring the location on a Remington 1100, and duplicating that on the 303. Drill a 1/8" shallow hole in the Berretta extension with a cobalt drill bit, and silver solder the button in place.
